Air Operations Training Programmes



Initial Requirements for Courses:

Candidates must have successfully completed some major trainings before and gained the skills listed below;

- 1. Knowledge of Basic Military Rules and Techniques
- 2. 7200 meters run with 20 kg backpack in 52 minutes or less
- 3. %60 + achievement on rifle and pistol shootings
- 4. 150 Meters FreeStyle Swim in 4 minutes or less

Candidates showing success during tests of above requirements are accepted into the air operations training programmes.

Air Operations Training Programmes

Training Subjects:

In addition to usage of instruments such as various arms / weapons, boats, electronic simulation systems and first aid simulation systems, Air Operations Training Programme includes;

- 1. Parachute Course
- 2. Helicopter / Aircraft Directing Procedures Course
- 3. Electronic Warfare

Skills to be Gained at the End of the Course:

At the end of the course, candidates showing the qualifications of;

- 1. Parachuting
- 2. Freefall
- 3. High Altitude Jumping
- 4. Aircraft and Helicopter Directing
- 5. Ability to use electronic instruments to improve electronic warfare skills

are awarded with "Certificate of Air Operations Expert"

Duration of Course:

Trainings including theoretical trainings, practices and simulations last 6 weeks in total



Aviation Courses



SADAT A.S. has capability of graduating Fighter Pilots for demanding countries by providing three different courses as "Pilot Training Programme", "Primary Aircrafts Training Programme" and "Advanced Fighter Pilot Training Programme" for any type of aircrafts and helicopters by its professional teams, whose members, to play active roles as instructors, are experienced pilots retired from Turkish Armed Forces after successfully completing their services.

Pilot Training Programme

SADAT A.S. plans, coordinates and implements the Pilot Trainings at international norms in demanding countries. Pilot Trainings can be specified for special requirements as well. Time Schedules for standard training programmes may differ from 1 year minimum up to 2 years maximum.

Pilot Certifications can be suited for the requirements of countries or trainings can be adapted for countries' already-though standards.

Primary Aircraft Training Programme

Besides The Attack Crafts Trainings, SADAT A.S. classifies and plans trainings for the pilots, who have successfully completed "Pilot Training Programme" before, to orientate candidates on to different types of aircrafts to be flown. Those aircrafts may be attack crafts, cargo crafts, tanker crafts, AWACS or helicopters. Depending on the Aircraft types already used by the countries or to be purchased in the future, the planning and implementations of aircraft training programmes may be performed inside the country's territory or in contracted-third partying countries after the worldwide investigations by SADAT A.S.

Advanced Fighter Pilot Training Programme

SADAT A.S. provides Fight Trainings for the pilots, who have successfully completed the Primary Aircraft Training Programme, in countries' territory if requested. These trainings require long-term duration and can be specialized for the countries' needs. By evaluating the threat perceptions of countries, the training programmes can be reformed or upgraded if necessary.



Helicopter Pilots Training Programme



Aim of the course, for Islamic and Friendly Countries, is to grow and train military and civilian pilots who are to fly any type of helicopter likely Turkish Pilots who fly all types of military and commercial helicopters and to execute yearly renewal and control flights and to teach new aviation developments.
